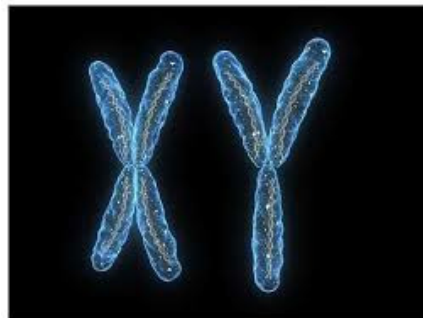
However, the Biblical reference is a bit of a misnomer, because this ‘Adam’ was by no means the only man alive 4400 years ago (*but moving forward..*)

Similarly, in theory, ALL mitochondrial genomes today should be traceable to a single woman, a mitochondrial ‘Eve’ whereas the Y chromosome is passed from father to son, the mitochondrial DNA (mtDNA) is passed from mother to daughter and son.

In 1987 population geneticists first demonstrated the existence of such a ‘mitochondrial Eve’ After analysing mtDNA from many people from around the world and charting their genetic relationships.. A ‘molecular clock’ was developed, based on the number of DNA mutations that exist in each genome generation, thus, is how Eve's age is estimated...

(textbook illustration)



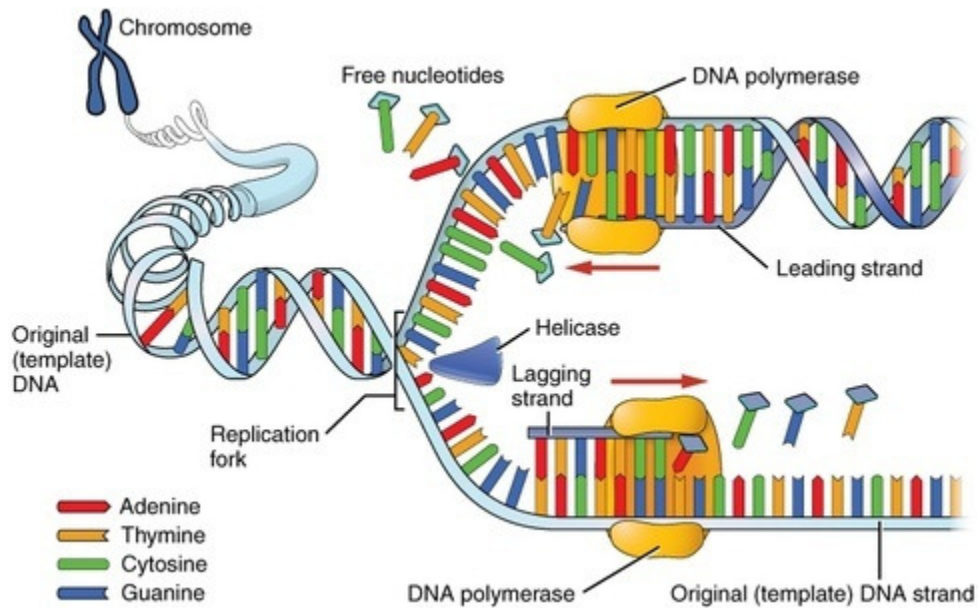
X, Y Chromosomes

(under a microscope)





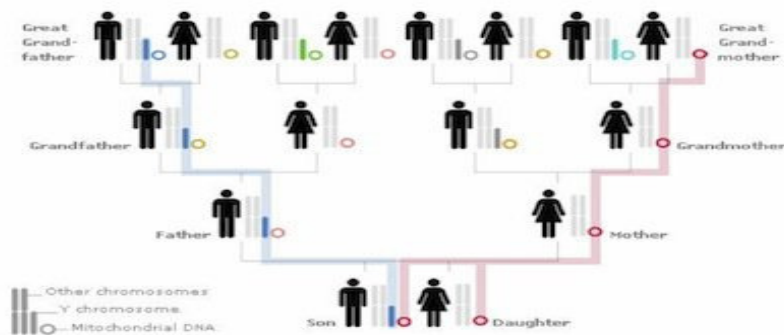
